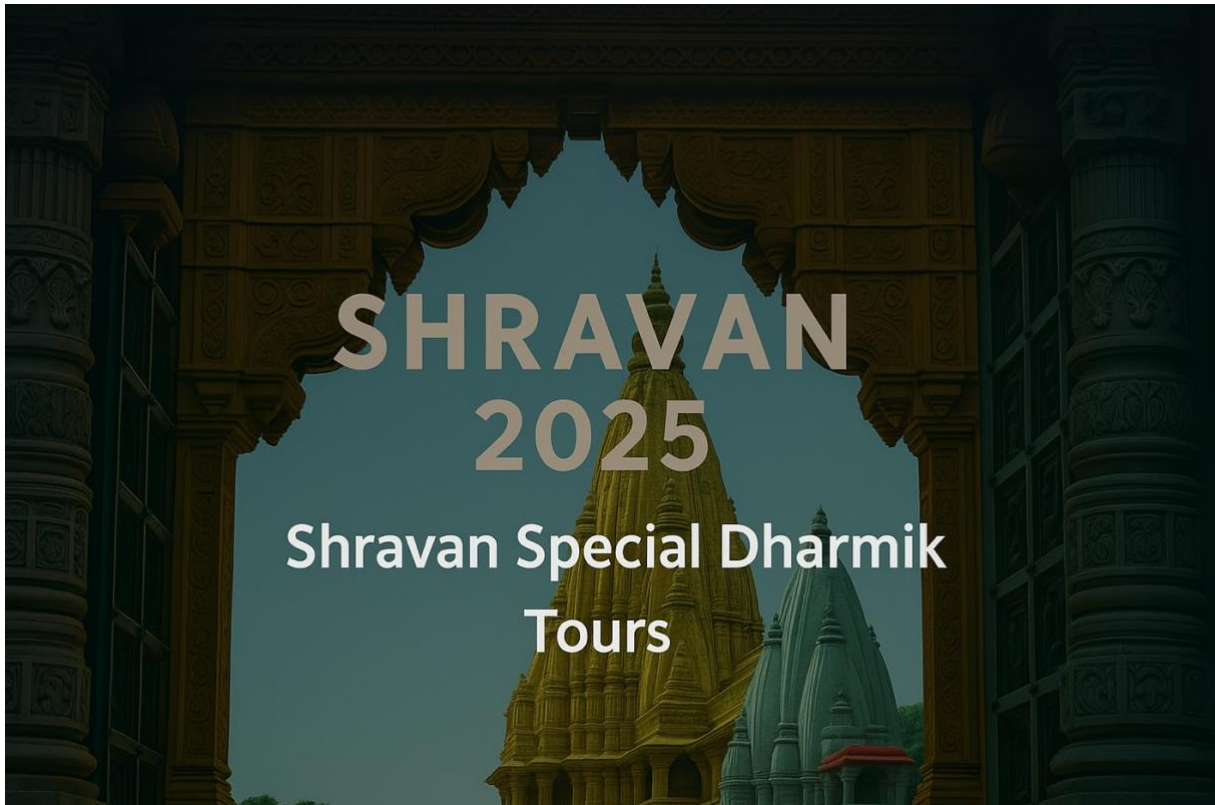


Shravan Month Special Yatra: Journey to Kashi Vishwanath Dham and Sacred Jyotirlingas Across India

Significance of Shravan Month: Myth, Meaning & Devotion

The Cosmic Churning – Samudra Manthan

According to Hindu scriptures, during the churning of the ocean (Samudra Manthan), a **deadly poison called Halahala** emerged that threatened to annihilate creation. In a supreme act of compassion, **Lord Shiva consumed this poison**, holding it in his throat to prevent devastation—thus becoming **Neelkanth**, the one with a blue throat.

To honor this act of cosmic sacrifice, the month of Shravan is **dedicated entirely to Lord Shiva**. Every offering during this period is said to yield **manifold spiritual merit**.

Shravan Somwars – The Pillars of Devotion

Every Monday of Shravan is known as **Shravan Somwar**—a day of fasting, chanting, and Shiva puja. Devotees offer:

- **Milk**, symbolizing purity
- **Bel leaves**, symbolizing surrender
- **Water**, symbolizing emotional cleansing

These rituals are aimed at awakening **inner consciousness**, overcoming ego, and attaining spiritual evolution.

Why Kashi?

Kashi (Varanasi) is **Shiva's eternal city**, where time stands still and spiritual vibrations elevate the soul. The **Kashi Vishwanath Temple**, situated on the banks of the Ganga, is one of the **12 Jyotirlingas**—the holiest abodes of Lord Shiva.

Pilgrimage to Kashi during Shravan is believed to **erase lifetimes of karmic debt** and liberate the soul from rebirth.

Weekly Adornments (Shringar) at Kashi Vishwanath

Every Shravan Monday features a **divine Shringar** representing a form of Shiva:

- **July 14:** Movable Idol Shringar
- **July 21:** Gauri-Shankar (Shiva-Parvati) Shringar
- **July 28:** Ardhanarishwar Shringar
- **August 4:** Rudraksha Shringar
- **August 9 (Purnima):** Jhula (Swing) Shringar

These adornments bring out the **philosophical, meditative, cosmic, and playful forms** of Shiva.

Daily Aartis at Kashi

1. **Mangala Aarti** (4 AM): The first call of the day
2. **Shringar Aarti** (6 AM): Adorning the Lord
3. **Bhog Aarti** (11:30 AM): Offering food
4. **Saptarishi Aarti** (7 PM): Performed by seven priests
5. **Shayan Aarti** (10:30 PM): Night offering and rest
