





## Day 01 – Arrive Kathmandu (1,400 m)

Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport to begin your divine journey. DharmikVibes team will receive you with warm hospitality and transfer you to your hotel. Evening orientation and group Bhajan session.

- Meals Vegetarian Dinner
- Accommodation 5-star hotel sharing basis
- Distance 5 to 10 km

#### Nepal Visa Guidance

Indian Yatris do not require a visa for Nepal but must carry a valid Passport or Voter ID. Aadhaar and Driving Licence are not accepted for flights.

Non-Indian passport holders can obtain a visa on arrival or apply online.

## Day 02 – Kathmandu Sightseeing and Fly to Nepalgunj (150 m)

Visit Pashupatinath Temple, Jal Narayan (Shesh Narayan), and Guheshwari Mata Temple.

Evening flight to Nepalguni (1 hour). Group briefing and devotional orientation session.

- Meals Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
- Accommodation 4-star hotel sharing basis



## Day 03 – Fly Nepalgunj to Simikot (2,910 m)

Early-morning flight to Simikot (weather-dependent). Rest and acclimatize to the mountain environment.

Short walk and group meditation in the evening.

- Meals Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
- Accommodation Guesthouse sharing basis

## Day 04 – Helicopter Simikot to Hilsa, Drive to Taklakot (4,025 m)

Board the chartered helicopter to Hilsa. After crossing the Nepal-China border on foot and completing immigration formalities, drive to Taklakot. Rest and hydrate to adjust to the altitude.

- Meals Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
- Accommodation 4-star equivalent hotel in Taklakot

**Note** – Hilsa is remote with limited facilities. Delays may occur due to weather or border formalities. DharmikVibes crew provides constant support and hot meals.

## Day 05 - Rest and Acclimatization at Taklakot

Spend the day in rest and devotion. Optional visit to Taklakot market for basic supplies. Light Bhajan and guided breathing session to help adapt to altitude.

## Day 06 – Drive to Lake Mansarovar (4,590 m)

A divine day as the group proceeds to Lake Mansarovar. Drive via **Rakshas Tal**, also known as Ravana Tal. Witness the first darshan of Mount Kailash and perform Rituals, Puja, and Meditation at the sacred lake under DharmikVibes guidance.

**About Mansarovar Lake** – The lake's crystal waters are believed to purify the soul. Yatris may perform holy snan using brought-up water by Sherpas as direct entry into the lake is restricted.

## Day 07 – 1st Day of Kailash Parikrama – Darchen to Dirapuk (5,210 m)

Drive to **Darchen**, the base camp of Mount Kailash, and visit **Yama Dwar**, the gateway to the sacred kora. Begin a 13 km trek toward **Dirapuk**, facing the North Face of Mount Kailash.

- Meals Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
- Accommodation Guesthouse near Dirapuk

Optional – Yatris unwilling to trek can remain at Darchen for rest and spiritual practice.

## Day 08 – 2nd Day of Parikrama – Dirapuk to Zutulpukh via Dolma La (5,630 m)

Trek through **Dolma La Pass**, the highest point of the Yatra, and witness the mystical **Gauri Kund**, the lake of Goddess Parvati. The trek is physically challenging but spiritually transforming.

- Accommodation Guesthouse in Zutulpukh



## Day 09 – End of Parikrama – Zutulpukh to Darchen, Drive to Taklakot

Short trek to Chongdo to complete the Kailash kora. Drive to Taklakot for rest and group thanksgiving ceremony.

- Accommodation Hotel in Taklakot

# Day 10 – Return Journey – Taklakot to Hilsa by road, Helicopter to Simikot, Flights to Nepalgunj and Kathmandu

Drive to the border, cross to Hilsa, fly by helicopter to Simikot, and then via Nepalgunj to Kathmandu. Weather conditions can affect timing, but DharmikVibes ensures smooth coordination and comfortable arrangements.

- **Medical fitness** is essential. Please undergo a health check-up before travel; individuals with heart, lung, or severe blood pressure issues should consult their doctor before booking.
- Acclimatization days are built into every itinerary avoid overexertion during these stages and stay hydrated.
- Respect local customs, monasteries, and sacred sites. Kailash and Mansarovar are not sightseeing destinations but **spiritual realms** revered by multiple faiths.
- Keep your passport, permits, and ID handy at all times. Tibet checkpoints require frequent document verification.
- Photography is allowed in most areas but prohibited at certain monasteries and army posts. Always follow your guide's instructions.
- Mobile networks are limited in the Tibet region inform your DharmikVibes coordinator before moving away from your group.
- Always follow your **group leader's** and **Tibetan guide's** safety instructions. Weather, terrain, or political factors may lead to sudden route or schedule adjustments.

  - o Dress in **layers** for flexibility between warm days and icy nights.
  - o Carry woollen jackets, thermal inners, gloves, mufflers, and caps.
  - o **Down jackets** are strongly recommended for the Parikrama.
  - o Evenings around Lake Mansarovar can be extremely windy and cold.



#### What to Carry

#### **Essential Items**

- Warm jacket or down coat nights near Mansarovar and Dolma-La are freezing.
- **Thermal innerwear** for warmth during early morning rituals and treks.
- Comfortable trekking shoes ensure good grip and ankle support.
- Modest layered clothing shoulders and legs covered during rituals.
- **Personal water bottle or hydration pack** refill from purified sources.
- Compact backpack large luggage will be carried separately by vehicle or porter.
- Woollen cap, gloves, muffler, and sunglasses essential for cold winds and UV protection.
- Rainproof poncho or jacket sudden showers or snow possible at high altitudes.
- **Personal medicines** including altitude sickness tablets, basic first aid, and prescribed medication.

#### **Recommended Additions**

- **Personal tent or camping gear** for those seeking a deeper meditative experience under the Kailash sky.
  - o DharmikVibes provides group camping facilities, but pilgrims are welcome to bring compact personal tents for **private meditation or solitude**.
- **Power bank or solar charger** limited electricity in remote camps.
- **Reusable cloth bag** for Prasad or small items; plastic is banned.
- **Earplugs or scarf** for strong winds during the night.
- Hand sanitizer, tissues, and wet wipes limited washing facilities.
- Cash (in small denominations) local vendors rarely accept digital payments.

## What Not to Carry

- **Heavy luggage** porters and yaks carry limited loads.
- Non-vegetarian food, alcohol, tobacco, or smoking items strictly prohibited.
- Plastic bottles or disposable items the region is ecologically sacred.
- Loud music or gadgets maintain spiritual silence.
- Valuables or jewellery unnecessary in pilgrimage zones.



#### **Spiritual Etiquette**

- Remove footwear before entering temples, monasteries, or performing rituals.
- Avoid touching or disturbing sacred stones, cairns, or prayer flags.
- Do not step into Lake Mansarovar; take water respectfully from its edge.
- Speak softly or remain silent during pujas, meditation, and Parikrama.
- Treat Mount Kailash as divine presence, not a mountain to conquer.
- Respect local lamas, monks, and fellow pilgrims of all faiths.

#### **Important Note for Pilgrims**

#### Please Note:

- During major auspicious periods (especially full moons, Guru Purnima, or Shravan month), the region experiences heavy pilgrim movement and strict border protocols.
- Expect enhanced security, documentation checks, and temporary travel restrictions by Chinese and Nepalese authorities.


